

# J. SEARLE BARCLAY

## Former Well-Known Sportsman Rowed on Columbia Crew

J. Searle Barclay of 59 West Forty-sixth Street, a member of an old American family and at one time a well-known sportsman, died yesterday in the Roosevelt Hospital after a long illness. His age was 69.

Born here, Mr. Barclay was graduated in 1898 from Columbia University, where he was a member of the varsity crew and Delta Phi fraternity. Afterward he continued for some years his enthusiasm for rowing.

Mr. Barclay long had managed his family's real estate holdings. Between the two World Wars he lived in Paris. He was a former member of the Knickerbocker, Brook, Racquet and Tennis and Turf and Field Clubs.

He leaves a widow, the former Nita Naldi, one-time motion-picture star.
