

The original and each copy of an application for a passport must have attached to it a copy of the applicant's photograph. A loose signed photograph of the applicant must accompany the application. The photographs must be on thin paper, should have a light background and be not over three inches in size.

Fee for passport, one dollar.  
Fee for executing application, one dollar.

I, J. Seale Barclay, a NATIVE AND LOYAL CITIZEN OF THE UNITED STATES, hereby apply to the Department of State, at Washington, for a passport, accompanied by my wife New York City (Name and place of birth.)

I solemnly swear that I was born at New York City, in the State of New York, on or about the 7<sup>th</sup> day of May, 1876;\* that my father J. Seale Barclay, was born in Parson, N.J. and is now residing at deceased

[that he emigrated to the United States from the port of (If the applicant's father or husband was born in this country, line should be drawn through the blanks in brackets.) on or about 1; that he resided 10 years, uninterruptedly, in the United States, from 1 1876 to 1 1886, at New York City; that he was naturalized as a citizen of the United States before the U.S. Court of New York, at New York, on 1, as shown by the Certificate of Naturalization presented herewith];

that I have resided outside the United States at the following places for the following periods: France, England, Egypt, from April 1910 to April 1910, from U.S. to U.S.

that I am domiciled in the United States, my permanent residence being at New York City in the State of New York, where I follow the occupation of Trustee; that I am about to go abroad temporarily; that I intend to return to the United States within 6 [months] [years] with the purpose of residing and performing the duties of citizenship therein; and that I desire a passport for use in visiting the countries hereinafter named for the following purpose:
